Dear Mr. Schnog:

The Commission has determined that the application for a state video franchise submitted by New Day Broadband on September 20, 2013 is incomplete. Pursuant to General Order 169 (IV)(A)(1)(a), an applicant must “submit a copy of a fully executed bond... to the Executive Director prior to initiating video service and no later than 5 business days after the date of the Commission’s issuance of a State Video Franchise to the Applicant.” Since New Day Broadband has been and is currently providing video service, a copy of its fully executed bond is required in order for the application to be complete. The Commission will make a further determination of completeness within 30 days of receiving the bond.
