Background:

Rulemaking 19-09-009 facilitates the commercialization and deployment of microgrids while prioritizing system, public, and worker safety and avoiding shifting costs between ratepayers. On September 12, 2019, the Commission initiated this Rulemaking to design a framework surrounding the commercialization of microgrids associated with Senate Bill (SB) 1339 (Stern, 2018), as well as to account for the Commission’s commitment toward utilizing additional technologies and activities that may be useful for achieving overall resiliency goals.

As part of the rulemaking, the CPUC is organizing a working group to facilitate thoughtful and informed discussions to continue to support the goal of resiliency and the commercialization of microgrids. Specifically, the RMWG will further explore issues not previously addressed or under current consideration by the Commission. The topics may be subject to change and reprioritization as the discussions evolve over the course of the working group meetings.

Purpose of the Meeting:

- Clarify rationale for proposed working group scope and issue prioritization in response to feedback.
- Review current projects and work related to multi-property tariffs.
- Share stakeholder and utility perspectives on opportunities and challenges related to standardization of multi-property tariffs.
- Learn about microgrid standards that are in development.
