**CPUC TO HOLD ADDITIONAL PUBLIC PARTICIPATION HEARINGS ON
PG&E'S REQUEST TO RETIRE DIABLO CANYON**

SAN FRANCISCO, August 25, 2017 - The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) will hold Public Participation Hearings to provide an opportunity for residents and organizations in the San Luis Obispo area to provide their perspective and input to the CPUC about Pacific Gas and Electric Company's (PG&E) request to retire its Diablo Canyon Power Plant.

The CPUC welcomes attendance, as public comments help the CPUC reach an informed decision.
