



**Golden State Water Company (GSWC)
General Rate Case – D.19-05-044
(Clearlake) District**

What does D.19-05-044 Authorize for GSWC?

**Increases in Operating Costs in the Following Areas Required
Increases in Utility Revenue to be Recovered in Rates:**

- Water supply costs (purchased water, pump taxes, purchased power, Chemicals)
- Salaries and benefits for GSWC employees
- Water infrastructure investments, Taxes, Rate of Return
- Other - Rent, Insurance, Purchased services

Increases in Utility Revenue – Clearlake District:

- 2019: \$0.07 million (3.1%) above authorized 2018 revenues
- 2020*: \$0.15 million (6.4%) above proposed 2019 revenues
- 2021*: \$0.15 million (6.0%) above proposed 2020 revenues

*Revenue increases for 2020 and 2021 are estimated using an escalation procedure and inflation factors. Actual increases may vary based on most recent inflation forecast at that point in time.

Clearlake 2019 Revenue to be Recovered in Rates - \$2,365,267

2019 Memorandum Account Recovery:

- 12-month surcharge of \$0.620 per ccf for memorandum accounts from 2013 Interim Rates and 2014 Water Conservation.





Residential Bill Impacts Based on Adopted Revenue Increases

Monthly Service Charge by Meter Size	Present Rates	2019 (% change)	2020 (% change)	2021 (% change)
5/8 - inch	\$40.25	\$40.76 (1%)	\$43.34 (6%)	\$45.92 (6%)
3/4 - inch	\$60.38	\$61.14 (1%)	\$65.01 (6%)	\$68.88 (6%)
1 - inch	\$100.63	\$101.90 (1%)	\$108.35 (6%)	\$114.80 (6%)
Water Usage Quantity Rate	Present Rates	2019 (% change)	2020 (% change)	2021 (% change)
Per Ccf	\$8.116	\$8.518 (5%)	\$8.999 (6%)	\$9.480 (6%)

Excluding CPUC fee, City Tax, surcharges and refunds, an average residential customer with a 5/8-inch meter using 5 CCF (1 CCF = 748 gallons) would see an increase in each bill from \$97.06 currently to **\$100.39** per month in 2019. The same bill would be **\$106.33** in 2020 and **\$112.28** in 2021 resulting an overall 15.7% rate increase over 3 years.
