On behalf of the Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission, Maria C. Solis, Aimee Cauquiran, Michelle Wei, Fred Hanes, and James Zhang conducted a General Order (GO) 112-E inspection of Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Emergency Plan from March 17<sup>th</sup> through March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2014.

The SED team used an internally developed Standard Inspection Report of a Gas Transmission Pipeline, Form -1; Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, as a reference guideline to conduct the inspection. The SED team did not find any probable violations of GO 112-E, Reference Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 192.615 and considers this inspection closed.
