The Safety and Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission, pursuant to GO 112-F and Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 192, §192.617 "Investigation of Failures" Directs Southern California Gas Company to test within 30-days (December 18, 2018) the failed pipeline component (Aldyl-A tee fitting) that is related to an incident that occurred on January 20, 2017, at 1748 South Mountain Ave., Ontario, San Bernardino County, CA.

SED will have an inspector present during the testing/examination of the failed pipeline component once scheduled.

Please confirm receipt of this Directive and provide SED the component test/ examination schedule and location.
